1. Title of the Practice

1. Title of the Practice

Celebrating Menstruation Week in collaboration with Yuva Seva Sadan, Piramal Foundation

2. Objective of the practice

To create awareness about menstruation among girl students.

3. The context

Menstruation is a natural human process occurring among girls after they attain puberty. It is common and everyone is in some way aware of it. However, there are several misconceptions and misunderstandings about it in the society at large. Even, girls are not completely aware about it which may lead to situation of complex health problems. There are several do and don't are associated with it in its societal-cultural background. However, they must have a scientific outlook towards it and pay more attention towards scientific do and don't in terms of care to be taken during menstruation period, cleanliness and hygiene, and removing baseless assumptions regarding the flowing of blood. In a state like Bihar where human development index is relatively lower than other states such organizing such awareness programmes becomes too important and urgently needed.
